Exchanged: Living Through the Spirit – The Exchanged Life

Reread Acts 2:1-12

1. Do you remember how the Holy Spirit was taught to you as a child? Share what you recall.
2. Have you ever known someone who seemed to “over rely” on the Holy Spirit? Why is that a problem?
3. What does the word that Jesus used to describe the Holy Spirit, Advocate, mean to you?
4. Why did Jesus tell the disciples in John 16:7 that it was good for him to go away? What do you think his followers thought about that statement?
5. Jesus promised the Holy Spirit would be given not only to us, but would be birthed within us. What, according to the Jesus, will be the work and purpose of the Holy Spirit in John 14:26
6. Can you recall a time that the Spirit of God taught you something that changed you or redirected some decisions?
7. Why do we have to learn to listen to the Holy Spirit? That is, why can it be so difficult?
8. In the message, Pastor Jon shared that the opposite of “living by the Spirit” is “Living under the law”. When do you know that you are living under the law rather than by the Spirit? Galatians 5:16-18
9. What is the difference between being committed to something or being surrendered to someone?
10. What can you do to “pay attention and keep in step” with the spirit this week?
