Re-read: Galatians 5:22-25

1. If you have a garden, what grows in it without you needing to be involved? What grows in it only with your help?
2. What do you think the Apostle Paul meant by telling us that we need to “live by the Spirit”? That we need to “keep in step or be guided by the Spirit”?
3. How are these two the same and how do they differ?
4. If we are “made alive by the Spirit,” why do we still struggle with sin?
5. How do you feel that you are presently “growing in the fruit of the Spirit”? “Being guided by the Spirit?”
6. Do you feel that you are living out what Paul meant by “Christ formed in you?”
7. What can or should you be doing to improve this growth and formation?
8. Which Spiritual Fruit/s do you feel are “growing and blossoming” in your life of faith right now?
9. Do any of these Spiritual Fruits feel like they're still in the “bud” stage?
10. If so, how can you and the Holy Spirit work together to grow these fruits in your life of faith?
