

Discussion Questions from message on Sunday, June 10

Surprised by Hope | Abraham - Promise

Re-read: Genesis 15:1-6

1. What was the biggest project around the house you ever tried to accomplish yourself?
2. The context of Genesis 15 is after “the fall” and the world had become a mess due to sin. What evidence have you seen this past week that the world is still a “broken” place?
3. What do we learn about the nature of God that God decided to clean up the mess? What were the options?
4. In the message, Pastor Jon shared that in order to bring a redeemer for the world, God had to get the world’s attention. How did God decide to do that?
5. Read Genesis 12: 1-3. Why did God choose Abram? What was the promise that was made to Abram?
6. Read Genesis 16:1-6. Why does Abram have little confidence in God’s plan?
7. When does your confidence in God’s plan for your life run low?
8. What do you think it meant for the Lord to reckon Abram righteousness?
9. How do we become righteous?
10. Do you have areas of your life that you find it difficult to trust God with? In other words, are you withholding your belief that God can take care of a specific thing, relationship or issue?
11. Can you ask your group to prayer for that specific need?
